

## **IFJ PAN Particle Physics Summer Student Programme**

### **Data protection**

Pursuant to art. 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 (Official Journal of the European Union L 119 of 4 May 2016), we inform you that:

1. the controller of your personal data is the Institute of Nuclear Physics Polish Academy of Sciences (IFJ PAN)

3. your personal data will be processed pursuant to:
  - art. 6, item. 1 letter b, c of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016, for the purpose of proper organization and settlement of the programme,
  - art. 6, item 1 letter c of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016, for the purpose of obtaining access card to IFJ PAN,
  - art. 6, item 1 letter a of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016, for the purpose of advertisement of IFJ PAN,
4. the recipients of your personal data will be solely:
  - entities entitled to obtain personal data under provisions of law,
  - entities cooperating with IFJ PAN within the framework of scientific collaborations or providing services for IFJ PAN
5. your personal data will be retained:
  - for the period necessary for proper organization and settlement of the programme, i.e. 5 years from the end of the calendar year in which the programme was organized,
  - for the purpose of promoting the event and informing about future scientific events organized by IFJ PAN - until the request for erasure of personal data is received by the controller
6. you have the right to demand access to your personal data, the right to request rectification and restriction of processing of your personal data as well as - in the case of processing for the purpose of promoting the event and informing about future scientific events organized by IFJ PAN - right to request erasure of your personal data processed for that purpose
7. you have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection,
8. providing your personal data is voluntary, but it is necessary for the participation in the programme.
